Storm Damage with Downed Trees Blocking OSRD Roadways

Ozark, Missouri

Primary Purpose:

The Ozark Special Road District will establish the following policy to clear District roadways blocked by storm damaged trees.

Storm damaged trees will be evaluated by employees of the District to determine if the damaged tree is in the District right-of-way or if the damaged tree was within private property.

Damaged trees determined to be in the Districts right-of-way, will be removed and disposed by the District.

Damaged trees blocking District roadways, determined to be from private property, will be cut at the ditch line and that portion blocking the roadway will be removed by the District.

The property owner will be responsible for additional cleanup of the remaining storm damaged tree debris within a reasonable amount of time, being 45 days.
