Core Responsibilities

- Serve as part of the governing body for the Ozark Special Road District.
- Make decisions as a Board, not individually.
- Set priorities for road maintenance and district operations.
- Approve budgets, expenditures, and contracts.
- Attend meetings and participate in discussions and votes.

Oversight of Employees

- Provide direction to employees only through Board-approved channels.
- Follow the Two-Commissioner Direction & Oversight Policy.
- Avoid issuing unilateral instructions or disciplinary actions.

Communication Expectations

- Maintain professional communication with employees and the public.
- Bring concerns to the Board for discussion rather than acting independently.
- Support consistent, unified messaging from the district.

Ethical Conduct

- Act in the best interest of the district and its residents.
- Avoid conflicts of interest.
- Follow all applicable laws and district policies.
